



AASD School Meal Program

Sponsored by the USDA & the Summer Food Service Program

- The Summer Food Service Program has been extended through December 2020. This program provides free meals, breakfast and lunch, for children ages 18 years and younger.
- Meals include five (5) breakfast and five (5) lunches and will be distributed weekly on Wednesdays, 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM, at the 13th Street entrance of the Altoona Area High School (near the Neil Armstrong Planetarium).
- Pre-Ordering meals is recommended to guarantee availability. Orders must be submitted on line or by calling 946-8270 no later than 10 AM each Friday. A new link to order will be posted every Monday on the AASD Facebook page and the AASD Webpage.
- Students PreK – 5, all students who attend traditional school are eligible for free breakfast and lunch at school. Because meals are provided at school, these students are not eligible for the weekly pick-up.
- Students who choose to pack lunch may purchase milk or juice using their child's MySchoolBucks account or lunch account.
