

AASD School Meal Program Sponsored by the USDA & the Summer Food Service Program

- The Summer Food Service Program has been extended through December 2020. This program provides free meals, breakfast and lunch, for children ages 18 years and younger.
- Meals include five (5) breakfast and five (5) lunches and will be distributed weekly on Wednesdays, 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM, at the 13th Street entrance of the Altoona Area High School (near the Neil Armstrong Planetarium).
- Pre-Ordering meals is recommended to guarantee availability. Orders
 must be submitted on line or by calling 946-8270 no later than 10 AM
 each Friday. A new link to order will be posted every Monday on the
 AASD Facebook page and the AASD Webpage.
- Students PreK 5, all students who attend traditional school are eligible for free breakfast and lunch at school. Because meals are provided at school, these students are not eligible for the weekly pickup.
- Students who choose to pack lunch may purchase milk or juice using their child's MySchoolBucks account or lunch account.
